



INVESTITURE

Your child has been coming to Cubs for a number of weeks now and is nearly ready to become a Cub Scout. We would like to have the investiture ceremony at 8pm during the Cub meeting on Thursday _____. Parents and siblings are welcome to attend.

To be invested your child will need to know their Cub Scout Law and Promise. These can be found in the information booklet or on the green card they were given. They will need to recite the law from memory and make their promise in front of the Pack.

The uniform your child will need to wear at meetings from this point forwards is as follows:

- Cub Scout Uniform Sweatshirt
- Long navy trousers
Uniform trousers are available but any navy trousers (not jeans) are acceptable
- Dark coloured trainers and socks (non-marking soles please)
