



INDOOR CUB PACK HOLIDAY KIT LIST

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT ALL ITEMS ARE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

and they know where things are marked

Clothing should be old, not 'best'. Cubs Scouts are **not allowed** to have knives. Expensive items such as cameras, electronic games, ipods, etc, **must not** be brought to camp. No responsibility will be taken for such items. Children may like to bring a disposable camera.

We are sleeping and eating indoors, but as far as possible we will be doing activities outside so your child should come prepared for this. The hut does have heating.

- Holdall:** All personal kit should be packed in **one** holdall or kitbag (although sleeping bag may be separate) and **labelled with your child's name and Pack** (3rd Edgware)
- Bedding:** A sleeping bag. Bedding may be packed separately but in a waterproof covering (strong polythene bag or sheeting), **clearly labelled with the owner's name and Pack**
- Clothing:** Complete and correct uniform, including shoes - **worn on arrival at camp**
Plimsolls or trainers
Wellington boots
Slippers or soft shoes to be worn indoors only
Sufficient tee shirts
Sufficient pairs of socks and underwear
Small polythene bags for dirty clothing
1 pair of pyjamas/tracksuit to sleep in
Warm jumpers/sweatshirts
Sufficient pairs of trousers (**NOT** jeans), ie track suit bottoms
Jacket or anorak
Waterproof coat **with hood**, ie cagoule
Capel
- Toilet kit:** 1 towel
Sponge bag containing: flannel, soap in a soap dish, toothbrush, toothpaste,
Hairbrush and comb
- Miscellaneous:** Torch, complete with spare batteries
Notebook and pen
Pillow if required (preferably an inflatable one)
Book or comic to read
- Sweets/tuck:** None to be brought.
- Pocket money:** Only a small sum, in a NAMED purse or wallet – up to £5.00, preferably in change
